Our school initiatives are showing substantial progress toward our targets



After reviewing our 2018 *Investing for Success* agreement, it is clear that we have made progress toward our targeted student outcomes. We will continue to focus on maximising the benefits of this funding for our students, and adjust our initiatives as needed to ensure every student succeeds.

Initiatives implemented include:

Initiative 1. Develop and align curriculum frameworks and models to Version 8 Australian Curriculum with a focus on English.

- Baseline data around teacher curriculum knowledge was established.
- 80% of staff APR's were completed online using the AITSL reflection tool.
- PD was delivered to all staff on English, Mathematics and Science V8.
- Year level curriculum planning days were implemented each term.
- Data triangulation of NAPLAN, English A & E and reading was conducted each semester in year levels.
- Achieving 66% NMS (Metro Benchmarks) each term in 2018.
- Achieving 28% P-3 and 44% 4-6 in U2B (Metro Benchmarks) each term.





Initiative 2. Deepen teacher knowledge and understanding of the Australian Curriculum English.

- Reviewed teacher pedagogical practice in reading.
- Sampled English planning moderated by HOC's.
- Focused data analysis discussions conducted to ensure validity of A-E scores in English.
- A new pedagogical framework endorsed for use in 2019.
- A new coaching model developed for implementation in 2019.
- New Active Learning Team established combining Playgroup/Pre Prep and Prep.
- A-E English target of Year 4 75% C or above resulted in Semester 1 2018 – 76% C or above.
- Achieved 100% of teachers enacting V8 Australian Curriculum English.
